

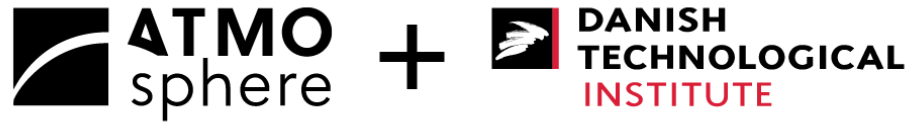

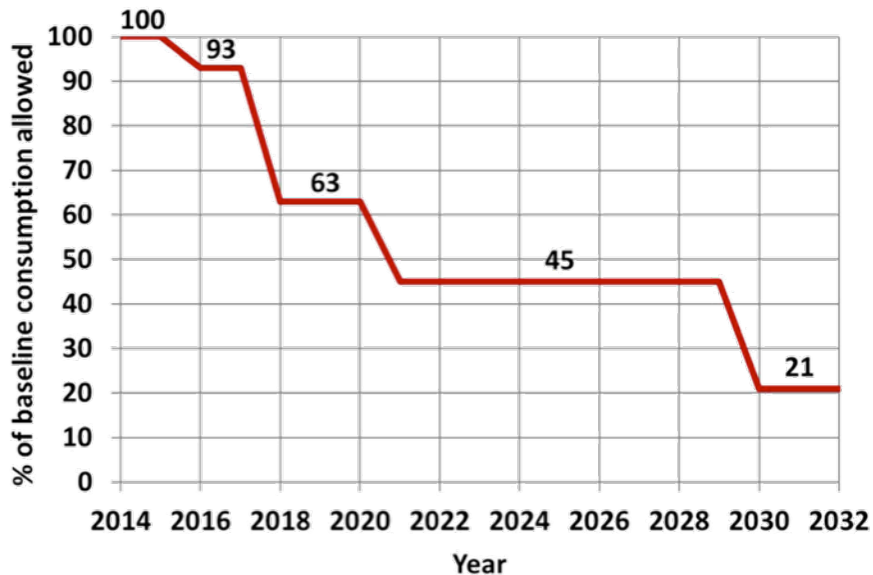
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## 2. EU F-Gas Regulation: Objectives

- European Union legislation **to control** F-Gases
- **Limits the total amount** of F-Gases sold in the EU from 2015 onwards
- **Bans the use** of F-Gases in many types of equipment where less harmful alternatives are widely available
- **Preventing emissions** of F-Gases from existing equipment

## 2. EU F-Gas Regulation: HFCs Phase down



The **F-Gas quota** dictates the admissible amounts of HFCs that can be placed on the EU market:

- 93% (2016)
- 63% (2018)
- **45% (2021)**
- 21% (2030)

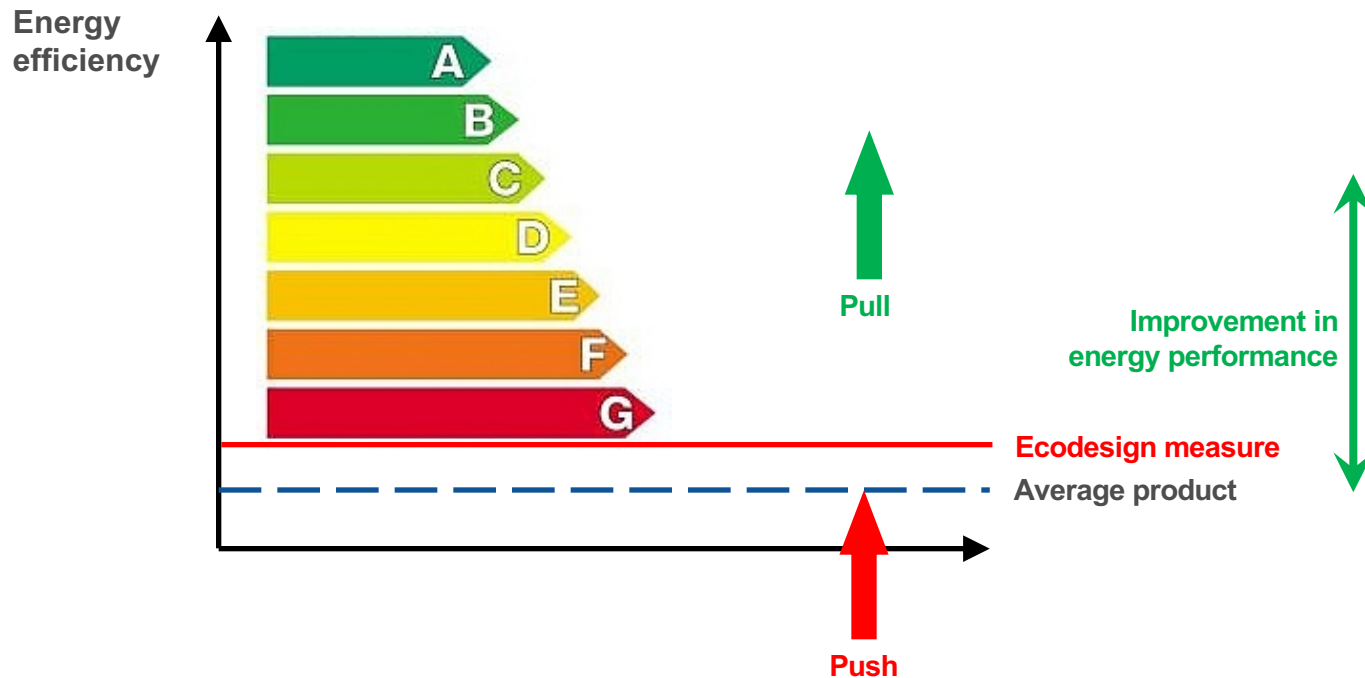

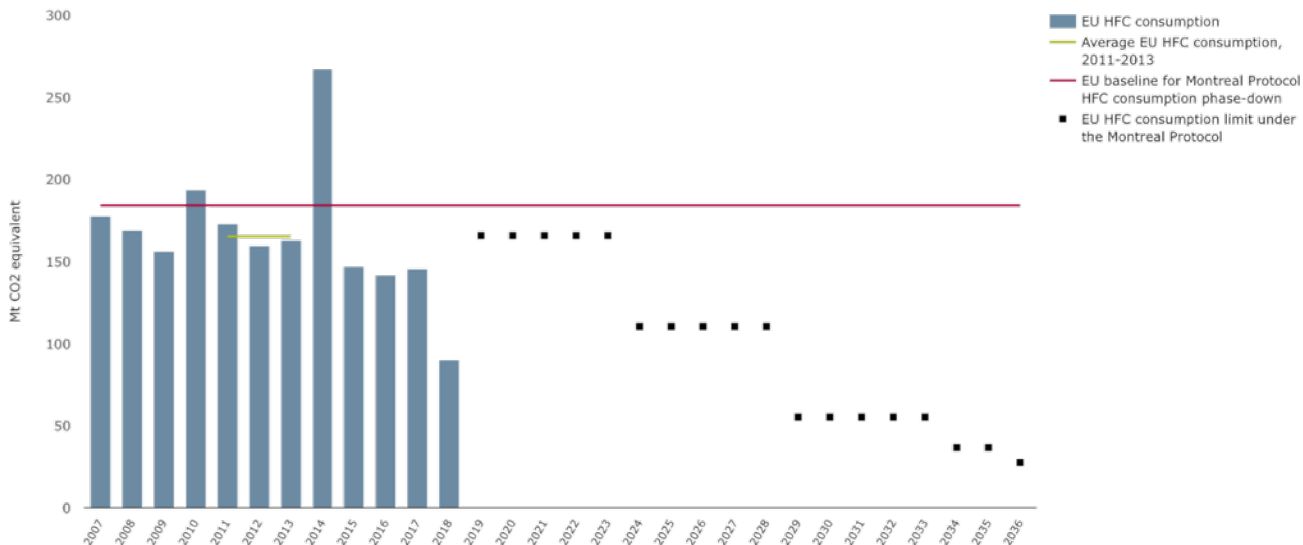


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# 5. EU progress towards the worldwide HFC consumption phase-down under the MoP

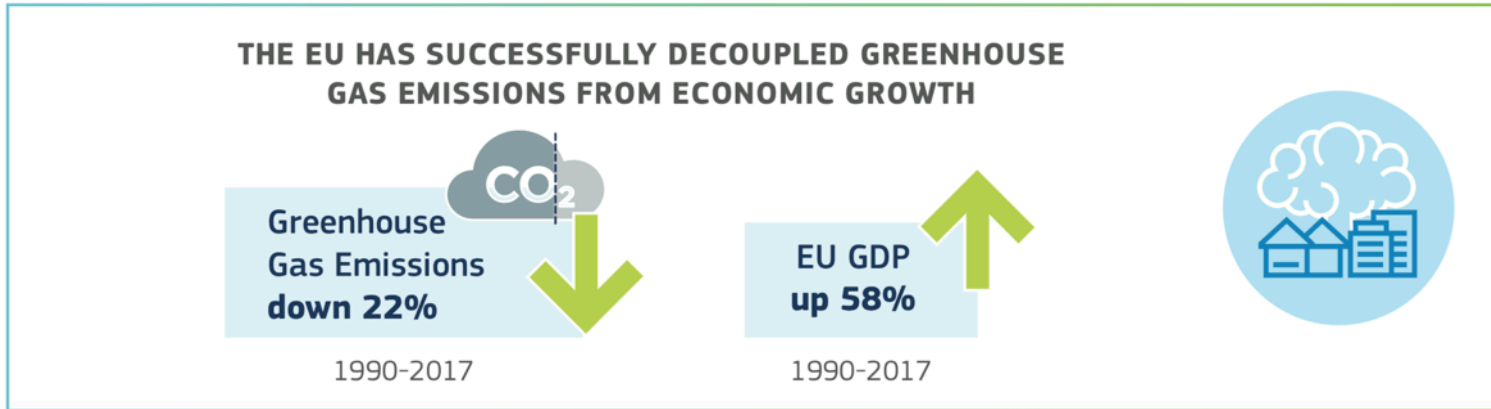
F-Gas and Ecodesign regulations:
